<b>Overview:</b>	Family-owned Maryhill Winery is the 15 <sup>th</sup> largest winery in Washington state. Nestled along the Columbia River among rows of vines, Maryhill is a popular destination for picnics and special events, with an adjacent 4,000-seat outdoor amphitheatre that hosts a world-class summer concert series.
<b>Location:</b>	Located at the Southern tip of the Columbia Valley appellation, the winery is perched on a bluff overlooking the Columbia River against the stunning backdrop of Mt. Hood.

<b>Vineyard Sources:</b>	Maryhill sources grapes from some of the most highly-regarded vineyards in the state including: Alder Ridge, Celilo Vineyard, Gunkel Family Vineyards, Milbrandt Vineyards, and Tudor Hills Vineyard.
<b>Wines:</b>	Maryhill produces 19 varietals and a total of 27 award-winning wines. Offering something for every palate, our wines offer tremendous value with exceptional quality at accessible price points.
<b>Awards:</b>	Maryhill has won more than 500 awards in both national and international competitions in the past six years.
<b>Distribution:</b>	Maryhill wines are currently distributed in 17 U.S. states, and are available for sale in our tasting room and through our website.
<b>Tasting Room:</b>	Maryhill's 3,000-square-foot tasting room draws more than 75,000 wine enthusiasts from around the globe each year, ranking among the top five most visited wineries in the state.
