Grenache (aka Garnacha) produces rich, flavorful red wines and deep, ruby-tinted rosé. The French have championed this grape in the Southern Rhône Valley but it's original home is Spain!

By mid-June, the weather had turned and was warming up faster than historical numbers and by mid September throughout Washington the weather was pushing ahead. A wonderful Indian summer allowed for fruit ripening and held balanced acid levels as the fruit ripened well for the rest of the growing season.
